This guide outlines a path for degree completion at Webster University for the Bachelor of Arts in Management

WEBSTER DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:

A minimum of 128 credit hours consisting of the following:

- Applicable University Global Citizenship Program hours
- 39 Required credit hours for the Major
- Electives

IMPORTANT TRANSFER NOTES:

- Webster has a minimum residency requirement that 30 of the student's last 36 credits must be taken at Webster University. All students must have a minimum of 128 credit hours to graduate.
- A minimum of 18 credit hours of academic work must be taken at Webster University in the Walker School of Business & Technology.
- No more than one course completed with a grade of D may count toward fulfilling the specific requirements of the Management major. All General Education/Global Citizenship Program courses must be completed with a C- or higher.
